EXTENSION LECTURE

Extension lecture by Prof. Arvinder Ansari



An extension lecture was held at Women's Studies Centre University of Kashmir on 9th of April 2019 for the students of PG Gender Studies, by Prof. Arvinder Ansari, Department of Sociology, Jamia Milia Islamia, New Delhi, on 'Gender and Development'. While talking about the various approaches applied to the study of Gender and Development she stressed on the approaches needed to study gender and development. Prof. Ansari argued that women in earlier approaches were considered only as beneficiaries of development and were not involved in the process of development. Women in Development approach focused on the importance of women as the major contributors of development while working in care economy as care takers and household workers. Women in Development was influenced by liberal feminism and modernization theory. It focused on equity and welfare of women. Liberal approach focused on enlightened educated mothers and wives. Prof. Ansari also deliberated on Women and Development and Gender and Development approaches. Women and Development focused on radicalistic approach where women were considered as shapers of development. In the end she stressed that feminist approaches do not seek to replace patriarchy with matriarchy but they are working towards gender neutrality.

AWARENESS CAMPAIGN AT NARGISTAN ARIPAL, TRAL (DISTRICT PULWAMA)



Continuing the community awareness camp in Tral, under the project assigned to CWSR by RUSA, the CWSR team went to Nargistan, Gujjar Basti Tral which is located at around 25 kms away from main Tral.

The team including Prof. Tabasum, Dr Roshan Ara and Dr Shazia started the camp with awareness speeches on the importance of health and hygiene of women. They were sensitised particularly on issues of reproductive health and menstrual hygiene.

The team also made the women aware about differential nutritional requirements of men and women. They also distributed some important supplements like folic acid tablets, Vitamin D3 etc. essential for women's overall health.

With the help of CWSR's associate, Social activist Zahid Parwaz Chaudhri a collective of 20 women have been identified on spot to take lead in skill development training initiative.

In the end Prof Tabasaum assured the women of Gujjar Basti of every kind of support from CWSR, University of Kashmir.

WEBINAR ON DRUG ABUSE/ADDICTION

District Legal Service Authority in collaboration with Centre for Women's Studies and Research, University of Kashmir conducted a webinar on Drug abuse/ addiction. Webinar was formerly started by Adv. Amtul Basit Deva, she welcomed all the participants. She said that a Psychoactive substance use often tends, to be framed as a problem or a menace in public health or social welfare conferences or discussions, the exact extent of substance abuse use in Kashmir is not assessed adequately. Psychoactive substances such as alcohol, cannabis and opioids has been observed in Kashmir from many years.

In Kashmir, the drug addiction has been on rise for past few decades. almost 2.5 lakh youth is addicted or we can say affected population. The use of psychoactive substances causes significant health and social problems for the people who use them and also for others in their families and communities; using of psychotropic drugs is a self-destructive pattern that causes distress and problems and some use for the purpose of creating pleasurable effects on the brain. She said that under the influence of various narcotic drugs, people see images, hear sounds and feel sensations that seems real but do not exist, it has been observed that the valley has a tremendous rise in the substance abusers over the past decade.

Mr. Basit Deva said, Medical opiates such as morphine and codeine or Benzodiazepine were first used as recreational drug, later Cannabis was more widely used but over the past few years heroin and cocaine have been used abundantly and they have great health risks and financial risks also.

The second speaker was Adv. Naveed Gul, Penal Lawyer DLSA, said that according to Magnitude of Substance Abuse Survey(2019) about 2.1% of the country's population (2.26 crore individuals) use opioids which include opium (or variants of Poppy husk) which is grown in the villages, heroin(or its pure form- brown sugar). He also added that there are many reasons for drug problems in the valley, which includes living in conflict zone, lack of awareness, easy availability etc. He said that according to Ministry of Social Justice and empowerment 4.6% of total population of J&K use opioid drugs which accounts for 805 of addicts in Kashmir. He also explained The NDSP Act 1985 which is an Act of the parliament of India that prohibits/ manufacturing, cultivation/possession/ sale/ purchasing/ transport/consumption of narcotic drugs or psycho-trophic drug abuses or substance.

At the end he stressed that it's high time to save our generation from the drug abuses.

The third speaker was Ms. Laifa Qureshi, Psychologist, she said that drug addiction is considered as a neurobiological disease. when a person becomes a drug addict it is very hard for him/her to spend a day without taking the drug. drugs that are the main cause of addiction are heroin, opium, morphine, inhalants, diazepam etc. It's important to mention that only psychiatrists can provide psycho-trophic drugs and that too after ten sessions. drug addiction in Kashmir is continuously increasing among students, both males and females.

She further added that addiction, overdose and other side effects disrupt families, personal lives and professional lives. unfortunately, this leads to assumptions and stereotypes about those who use drugs. With the right treatment, recovery is possible. anyone can overcome substance abuse and related issues. Anyone can build a life that is safe, sober and free from substance abuse side effects.

The last speaker was Irfan Malla, P.G student CWSR, university of Kashmir, he said that as we know that Kashmir is one of the most militarized conflict zone of the world. the turmoil of the past many years has caused depression and psychological problems among a huge number of people and due to this depression, majority of people have found drugs to be the only solution to get rid of the stress. He concluded his speech by saying that all of us must collectively share the responsibility to get rid of this menace.

At last Ms. Basit concluded the webinar by saying that to curb this problem the first and foremost step which Government of J&K must take is to take strict action against drug peddlers, opioid cultivators and chemist -shops who sell psycho-tropic medicines. another important responsibility is of parents and teachers, instead of scolding or treating them harshly, they must deal with them with love and patience. They must try to increase their morale and confidence.

Parents must also consult professional interventionists to help find the real cause of stress and ways to manage it. NGO's , Government, schools and colleges should regularly organize programmes and seminars to sensitize students and general masses about repercussions of drug abuses. It's imperative to eradicate the roots of drug addiction from our society.

After a productive webinar, constituting a lot of knowledge sharing through different participants who had joined the webinar from diverse fields, Ms. Basit thanked Coordinator, CWSR, University of Kashmir, and Secretary District Legal Service Authority, convener for this Webinar, she expressed her gratitude to the team of CWSR and all those who had put their efforts to organize and make this webinar a success. She was of the view that more such programmes should be organized for knowledge sharing and awareness and the institutions should collaborate with each other so as to give a platform to research scholars and students wherein they can share and learn from each other's work and experiences.

AWARENESS CAMPAIGN

“Breast Cancer & Reproductive Health of Women” At Ladroo, Pahalgam (District Anantnag)



Centre for Women's Studies (CWSR), University of Kashmir is organized an awareness camp on "Breast Cancer and Reproductive Health of Women" as a part of a series of programmes already been organized elsewhere and more to follow afterwards, under its community-based outreach project work associated with Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) in a far-flung Gujjar village named, Wangidar, Halqa, Ladroo Block, Pahalgam. The programme began with a formal rapport building session where in a proper introduction of the programme was provided by Prof. Dr. Tabasum Firdous, Director, CWSR to all the indigenous participants who were approximately 40 in number. The local participants were predominantly Gujjar women however, presence of few male members was also seen that made the programme even more inclusive and completely community oriented. The participants were given enough time to reveal their health-related issues followed up by comprehensive counselling sessions both individually as well as collectively led by Prof. Dr. Tabasum Firdous and followed up by Dr. Roshan Ara, Dr. Shazia Malik, Dr. Rabia Bazaz. The sessions were also facilitated by: Dr. Abdul Basit, Dr. Zahid, Dr. Suhayl Hakak. Following the counselling sessions, some basic/primary medication was also provided to most of the participants including, iron and calcium supplements, Vitamin B complex supplements etc. In the valedictory remarks, Prof. Tabasum thanked all the local participants and appreciated their zeal and zest and most importantly promised them that a few skill-based vocational centres will be launched in the near future to identify and broadcast the local economic potential of the female folk.

Other than that all the students had a great experience of observing things first hand, a momentary detour from the routine theoretical paradigm into a more practical domain.

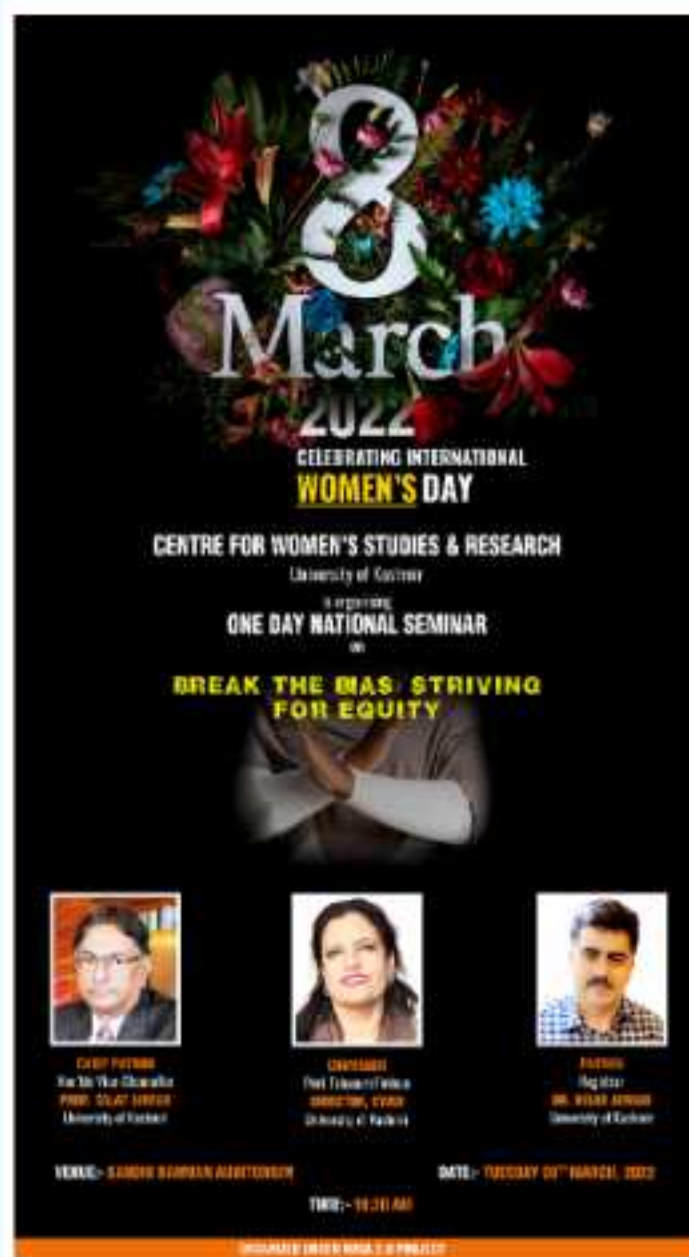





KU's CWSR holds health outreach programme in Poonch

SRINAGAR: Kashmir University's Centre for Women's Studies and Research (CWSR) organised an outreach programme on Breast Cancer and Reproductive Health of Women in Poonch.

The day-long programme, organised as part of a RUSA project, was held at Government Girls Higher Secondary School Mandi to create awareness among adolescent girls and women on key health issues.

Director CWSR Prof Tahira Hudaib educated the participating women about prevention of breast cancer.

She said breast cancer is one of the most prevalent cancers in J&K and it is therefore important to raise awareness among young women on how it can be prevented. She said early detection is the key to prevention of breast cancer.

Prof Hudaib said the Vice-Chancellor Prof Nisha Khan has assured her full support to such outreach



programmes which are aimed at educating underprivileged and marginalised sections of the society about important health issues.

Dr Rashid Anwar, senior faculty at CWSR, focused on socio-cultural manifestations of health in general and reproductive health in particular.

Dr Farooq Hameed, Surgeon District Hospital Poonch spoke about several health issues including reproductive tract infections due to improper menstrual hygiene, sexually transmitted infections (STIs), human

immunodeficiency virus (HIV), unspiced pregnancies from lack of awareness about contraceptive practices and lack of proper guidance about sexual health. He also highlighted causes, prevention and treatment of breast cancer amongst women.

Dr Anis Bhat, Principal Government Girls Higher Secondary School Mandi and Ghulam Mustafa Shah, Lecturer, were also present on the occasion. Dr Barkat Choudhary, Vice Principal conducted proceedings of the programme.
