



HIGHLIGHTS OF GENDER AUDIT REPORT

- The positions such as University Syndicate members, Heads of Departments, Deans of Faculties, Deputy Registrars, are mostly occupied by male employees.
- **The number of female candidates pursuing PG courses in 2012-2013 was more compared to that of males.** It is noteworthy to mention that In the year 2016-17 there were 487 females and 268 males who enrolled in PG courses in the campus.
- The gender gap has decreased in the years 2012-16 in terms of award of Ph.d and M.phil degrees.
- Majority of Women i.e 85.38 per cent disagree having been harassed or bullied due to their gender in the departments of University


